wine description	The smell reminds on matured citrus fruits as well as birch flowering, luscious pears, Burgunder-typically creaminess. Lychee and carambola join in the mouth. Elegant, delicate style, refreshing character, savory play of acidity in the finish. Animating.
drinking suggestions	the allrounder fits ideally to fish and meat, also to breaded food
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	„Gebling“ of Rohrendorf The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe, Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards.
