wine description	On the nose fine herbs, underlaid with yellow fruit aromas, delicate apple, touch of tobacco, salty appeal. Juicy, white fruits, fresh structured finesse on the palate, lemony at the finish, salty minerality, animating style (Peter Moser, Falstaff)
drinking suggestions	for aromatic dishes, meat, pasta dishes
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	„Gebling“ of Rohrendorf (1^{ÖW} first site) The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and minerally Riesling.
