Grüner Veltliner Gebling 2013 (henceforward: Kaiserstiege) Kremstal DAC

the exotic one

wine description	Inviting yellow fruits with exotic touch. Orange and herbal notes. Juicy, animating acidity, repetitive exotic notes. Minerality. White pepper in the finish, pleasant final pressure.
drinking suggestions	„allround genius“ – fits always and everywhere
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria vineyard
vineyard	“Gebling” of Rohrendorf (first site) The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and minerally Riesling.

vinification	3 hours maceration time temperature-controlled fermentation
maturing	stainless steel
bottling date	12 th February 2014
alcohol	12.5 %vol.
total acidity	6.4 g/l
residual sugar	1.0 g/l – dry
