wine description	Fine aromas of nuts, subtle Orange marmelade, underlaid with ripe yellow apple fruit. Multi-faceted bouquet. Powerful, full-bodied, pleasant peppery spiciness, subtle honey, dark minerality, good lasting, high ripening potential. (Peter Moser, Falstaff)
drinking suggestions	everything which „tames“ this wine
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	„Gebling“ of Rohrendorf (1^{ÖTW} first site) The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and minerally Riesling.

vinification	6 hours maceration fermented in stainless steel
maturing	in 1.500-litre oak barrel for 9 months (new, untoasted)
bottling date	9 th February 2015
alcohol	14.5 %vol.
total acidity	4.0 g/l
residual sugar	1.0 g/l – dry
