Grüner Veltliner Karmeliterberg 2014 Kremstal DAC

the classical one

wine description	Varietal typical in the nose, inviting yellow fruit, herbs and grass flowers. The Karmeliterberg shows itself very straight and variety-typical, peppery, spicy, juicy. Makes appetite for more.
drinking suggestions	light appetizers and salads, perfect for Snacks with bacon or ham
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	“Gebling” of Rohrendorf The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one of the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and minerally Riesling.

bottling date	9 th February 2015
