### **the polished achiever**

wine description	Fine, yellow tropic fruit touch, papaya, mango and pineapple, fresh meadow herbs, a hint of honey. Complex, juicy, elegant texture, fine acidity. Seems to be nimbly, delicate orange flavor in the finish. Good potential for development. (Peter Moser, Falstaff)
drinking suggestions	instead of red wine, takes up with almost every dish
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	„Gebling“ of Rohrendorf ( <b>1<sup>ÖT</sup></b> first site) The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and mineral Riesling.

harvest date	28 <sup>th</sup> October 2015
vinification	4 hours maceration fermented in stainless steel
maturing	in 1.500-litre oak barrel (new, untoasted)
bottling date	24 <sup>th</sup> August 2016
alcohol	13.5 %vol.
total acidity	5.2 g/l
residual sugar	1.0 g/l – dry
