wine description	Attractive fruit fan, red berries, orange blossoms, apricots, papaya; fleshy-solid base, mineral, focussed fruit, clear, supple acid; precise varietal and terroir-character, fine length. (Bernulf Bruckner, Vinaria)
drinking suggestions	fits ideal to ethno-food (Asian, Indian)
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	„Gebling“ of Rohrendorf (1 <sup>ÖT</sup> first site) The Gebling is a significant hill north of Rohrendorf reaching down to Krems. It is a part of one the mightiest loess sediments in Europe. Its name – originally probably “Gelb-ling” (“yellowish”) – refers to blazing walls behind the vineyards. The terraces on Gebling, which start directly behind the cellar, are eminently suitable for spicy Veltliner and minerally Riesling.

vinification	destemmed clusters 4 hours maceration temperature-controlled fermentation
maturing	stainless steel tank
bottling date	17 <sup>th</sup> August 2017
alcohol	13.0 %vol.

residual sugar	1.5 g/l – dry





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
