wine description	Aromas of ripe cherries and berries in the nose, accompanied by a hint of soil. On the palate a very fruity style, with rounded tannins and a nice drinking flow.
drinking suggestions	dark meat, very spicy food, for Italian meat dishes
region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyards	a cuvee of different single vineyards at the plateau "Neubruch"
soil	different soil, loess, sandy, clay and some of this vineyards are with a gravelly soil
harvest date	19 th October 2015
vinification	3 weeks maceration temperature-controlled fermentation
maturing	stainless steel tank
bottling date	17 th August 2017
alcohol	13.0 %vol.
total acidity	4.9 g/l
residual sugar	1.6 g/l – dry
