region	Kremstal, Rohrendorf on the east side of the Danube in Lower Austria
vineyard	Neubruich - "Steinernes Meer" – (stoney sea) Millions of years ago with the primordial sea flooded some 1000 years later the ancient Danube and the ancient Traisen met there and brought a huge quantity gravel with them
soil	gravel
harvest date	26 <sup>th</sup> September 2012
vinification	4 hours maceration temperature-controlled fermentation
maturing	stainless steel tanks
bottle date	1 <sup>st</sup> March 2013
alcohol	12 %vol.
total acidity	6.9 g/l
residual sugar	1.0 g/l – dry
